7 Lessons from victims of sexual violence

1. Few victims ever tell about their experiences.
2. When they do, they tell someone close.
3. Fewer still seek services.
4. Those who seek services usually receive them.
5. Male victims are less likely to disclose.
6. The reasons for not disclosing or seeking services will surprise you.
7. Family relationships are key to risk and to disclosure.
