- Researcher:** When someone has to do a study and makes them feel bad about themselves, or call the children. Sometimes violence means hurting someone on their body, or taking their real opinion or making them feel you not based or justice.

It can also mean looking them for a way that does not make them feel good.

Researcher is someone from a university who wants to know or learn and asks people questions about their lives. Usually they talk about 30 minutes or 1 hour. Usually sometimes are private.
