


# Health Care Providers' Confidence and Acceptability of Screening for Gender-Based Violence in Mozambique



96%

Screening allowed to understand the relationship between GBV and health.

90%

Not fearful of offending the clients by screening.

89%

Confident asking the screening questions.

81%

Thought the colleagues who screened for GBV were very happy with the opportunity to identify survivors.

62%

Said that screening did not take more time than routine provision of services.

51%

51% cited a lack of privacy as an obstacle to talking to clients.
