


Challenges

<p>UNEMPLOYMENT</p> <p>66%</p>	<p>HIGH RATES OF CRIME & VIOLENCE</p> 	<p>ALCOHOL USE</p> <p>60%</p>
<p>RISKY SEXUAL BEHAVIOUR</p> 	<p>HIV TESTING</p> 	<p>DRUG USE</p> <p>87.8%</p>


Cluster randomized control trial
