
At least one form of domestic violence was experienced by 40.6% of married women



Only 69.6% of the married women are working



Only 42.6% of married women had capacity to make decisions in the family



Women who have low capacity to make decisions are **1.2X** more likely to experience D.V

Women who are not employed are **1.6X** more likely to experience D.V



Women who earn more than their husbands are **1.2** times less likely to experience D.V
