Findings

Through different methodologies, including an ethnographic analysis, a quantitative survey and in-depth interviews and a cross reference focus group- Mapa has been able to access crucial information to guide the project. Data that can be used both for the improvement of the intervention and for the articulation of its importance. This experience has improved our internal capacity, and we are now able to navigate a strategic balance between quotes and percentages.

Finding included social demographics of volunteers and beneficiaries, as well as a level of comprehension of the service provision. What made us celebrate the most is the overall beneficiaries felt stronger and more resilient after the intervention and attribute a great part of their rebuilding progress to the services offered through Mapa do Acolhimento.
